NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District (the "Board") will hold a regular public meeting at 19623 Windy Stone Drive, Katy, Texas 77449, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held Tuesday, January 6, 2026, at 12:00 Noon.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:



2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting of December 2, 2025;
3. Security Report;
4. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
5. Approve Continuing Disclosure Report; and authorize Continuing Disclosure Counsel to file Report with appropriate repositories (due February 28, 2026);
6. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports; authorize the payment of invoices presented;
7. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
8. Review of Delinquent Tax Collection Attorneys' Report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P.; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
9. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2026, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
10. Discussion of exemptions from taxation for 2026, and adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
